Public notice is hereby given that the regular meeting of the Huntsville Historic Preservation Commission will be held on Monday, December 9, 2024, at 4:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers on the 2nd floor of City Hall, 305 Fountain Circle, Huntsville, Alabama. The Commission will take action on the following items:

721 Randolph Avenue - Mary E. Holmon for Property Liaison Services LLC, applicant.
Primary residence: modify window configuration, remove rear addition and east entrance and extend rear roof; Secondary residence: alter front porch and windows, Construct new entrance on west elevation; Primary and secondary residence: replace siding, change paint colors, repair and replace select windows, replace roof and doors, construct carport, new patio and driveway.

811 Randolph Avenue - Chrissy and Eric Benzenhafer, applicants.
Construct rear rooftop addition, east side bay addition and west side two-story porch and staircase, replace attic vents and install brick front sidewalk.

1012 Beirne Avenue - Andrew Parker for Caroline Lang and Tim Brown, applicants.
Replace four windows.

410 Lincoln Street - Rob Owens for Katie and Brad Alley, applicant.
Construct carport addition.

404 White Street - Leigh and Todd Lackey, applicants.
Install front yard fencing and sidewalk gate.

715 School Street - Chris Clark for Minnie Newman, applicant.
Replace damaged windows and front door, remove awning and repair areas affected by storm damage.

208 Eustis Avenue - Paul Matheny for Church of the Nativity, applicant.
Construct porte-cochere and elevator tower at Joffrion Hall, install new interior elevator in Ridley Hall, enclose courtyard between Joffrion and Ridley Halls and reconfigure interior spaces for ADA accessibility.

Construct new two-car garage and driveway, partial enclosure of west side porch, replace deteriorated window sashes and adjust existing metal fencing and privacy fencing.
